

## YOUTH CAMP UPDATE – APRIL 24, 2009

In order to receive the package cost from Trent we must have a minimum of 25 registrants. The children will be staying at Otonabee College and take about a ten minute walk to the camp site. There is a portable classroom that will accommodate the children when required during the day.

The area consists of many hectares of diverse habitat including woodland, wetland and drumlins.

The [programme](#) will consist of hands-on activities and games all relating to our convention theme of Remember Yesterday – Protect Tomorrow. Swimming and campfire in the evening are sure to be pleasurable.

The children will partake in boxed lunches at the camp and take part in the same meals as the adults for breakfast and dinner (except the banquet).

Accommodation Thursday night and breakfast Friday morning can be arranged for youth camp attendees at a cost of approximately \$50.00.
