- 1. **Call to Order**: 12:55 p.m. The District 2 Director, Kathryn Lindsay, called the meeting to order and welcomed OHA D2 Society members and OHA guests.
- Approval of AGM Agenda with addition of Voting Rules:

- 3. Singing of O Canada
- 4. Charles Freeman, Director, District 1, explained the voting procedure as per the OHA Constitution. OHA constitution dictates that we distribute Yellow Cards for each qualifying vote for each society. There should the same number of delegates as there are votes. Possible number of votes is 52. When we need to vote, please hold up the yellow cards and they will be counted and results declared.
- 5. Charles Freeman, Director, District 1, then thanked the hosts for the venue, brought greetings from the OHA President and Board of Directors. The OHA Board and Executive met in March for a weekend of meetings to discuss issues and concerns. First, after years of discussion and much planning, we have finally engaged the services of Urban Design & Co to create a brand new Garden Ontario website for the OHA. Second, GardenOntario Week is back and scheduled for June 11-19, 2016. Lee Valley has agreed to sponsor GardenOntario Week this year and the Canadian Garden Council will be promoting our OHA events during their Garden Days which are held June 17-19. Lastly, the OHA will be supporting the Highway of Heroes Project which involves the planting of 117, 000 trees along Highway 401, between CFB Trenton and Keele Street in Toronto to honour our fallen Canadian soldiers. We will be soliciting donations from interested members, Societies and Districts to help create this living tribute. The OHA will match donations, up to a maximum of \$2,500.
