



DISTRICT 2 - OHA SERVICE AWARD



This award is an engraved wooden plaque provided by the Ontario Horticultural Association which is presented at the D2 Spring AGM.

One nomination may be made each year by each Society within a District to the District Director in a letter giving full details of the nominee's qualifications. From these nominations, the District Executive may select one award winner per year. The name of the recipient and the date of presentation are to be submitted to the Association Awards

Coordinator by the District Director at least four months before the award is to be presented. The Association Awards Coordinator maintains a listing of recipients.

The criteria to be followed in the selection of a candidate are:

1. An individual who has given effective, long service to a Society or District, preferably a minimum of fifteen years, in horticulture, exhibiting, or judging.
2. An individual who has given extensive service to horticulture, exhibiting, or judging exclusive of Horticultural Societies.

NOTE: Recipients of this award may only receive this award once.
