Small, but mighty, their garden has much to please the eye from the hens and chicks in the rock garden, the gorgeous clematis, the boxwood topiary, and the stately larch, to the interesting cacti surrounded by bursts of colour from the variety of flowering perennials. Cotoneaster spreads over one area while lavender, Russian sage, sedum, Scotch thistle and sea holly cover another. Blue spiderwort, columbine, copper yarrow, bachelor's buttons and rock asters abound, along with many beautiful hostas. The porch and house are brightened by colourful baskets of pink geraniums.
