Ontario Horticultural Association Pollinator Project Grants

The Ontario Horticultural Association (OHA) is committed to collaborating on a province-wide strategy to improve pollinator health. The OHA will provide ten (10) grants of \$200 each annually to eligible member societies to create habitat in the form of pollinator friendly gardens or nesting sites on public land.

Reporting Requirements: Successful Pollinator Grant applicants will be required to submit itemized original receipts, a completed project reporting form and a photo to the Awards Coordinator for reimbursement before December 31st of the next year. For example, a grant awarded in 2018 must have its completed report with receipts and photos submitted by December 31st of 2019. Otherwise the OHA will assume that the Pollinator Project Grant has not been completed and the grant monies will be cancelled. NO funds will be released without itemized receipts.

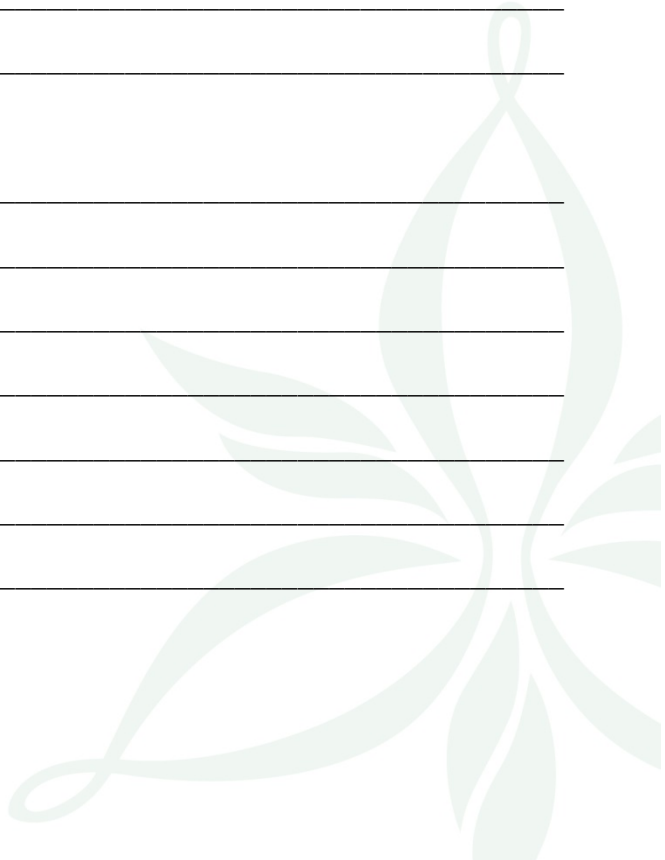
