This meeting was attended by 32 members. The business meeting followed the speaker presentation.

John Burgener, owner of Dynamic Day Lilies gave us an informative and colorful presentation about his obsession with growing bright and beautiful day lilies. He grows and hybridizes day lilies because they are beautiful, easy to grow from seed and there is an endless variety. John's presentation showed various vibrant photos of day lilies on his property in Beamsville. Unlike most growers who focus on muted and pastel shades, John is after brilliant colours. In his own words "if it isn't something that glows from a mile away, I am not really interested in it." He also aims to grow lilies that are unusual, have lots of flower buds and that bloom from June to October. John purchases many of his day lilies from Florida and then tries, over many generations, to hybridize the plants to thrive in the Ontario climate. Many of the plants photographed in his presentation had been painstakingly bred for seven generations. John recommends visiting his property in early July, as most day lilies bloom then. He kindly offered to host us at his property and serve our group lunch, if we call ahead to book a visit.
